



# 2026 Pay for Performance

**Ambetter is the #1 carrier on the Affordable Care Act’s Health Insurance Marketplace.**

The Ambetter plan design philosophy is to provide affordable care to individuals or families that need to purchase healthcare coverage on their own. Ambetter and PA Health & Wellness understand that the Provider-Patient relationship is a key component in ensuring superior healthcare and the satisfaction of our Ambetter Participants. Because we recognize these important partnerships, we are pleased to offer the 2026 Pay for Performance (P4P) incentive program for Ambetter, which rewards PCPs for improving quality and closing gaps in care.

The 2026 Ambetter P4P program is designed to enhance quality of care through a focus on preventative and screening services while promoting engagement with our members. The P4P program is “upside only” and involves no risk to you. It consists of 10 measures. Providers in the P4P Program can earn incentives at 2 levels based upon the established benchmarks for each measure. Target performance is determined by comparing a P4P provider’s compliance percentage for a given program measure to the established benchmarks. Each measure will be calculated and rewarded individually. Bonuses are calculated and paid out to the eligible Participant’s provider of record at the end of the applicable measurement periods as defined by the P4P Program.
