SCOPE:

This policy applies to psychotropic drugs prescribed to participants.

PURPOSE:

PA Health & Wellness will implement a psychotropic drug oversight program to reduce the prescribing of psychoactive medications to participants.

POLICY:

DEFEDENCES.

The Plan's psychotropic drug oversight program will:

- Measure psychopharmacology usage and prescribing patterns;
- Monitor the use of, and the claims related to, psychopharmacology to identify target populations for proposed interventions;
- Prepare participant-specific profiles of medication use based on pharmacy data to inform BH-MCO;
 - o Identify participants using 2 or more atypical antipsychotics
 - o Identify participants using 2 or more antidepressants
 - o Identify participants using 3 or more mood stabilizers.
- Coordinate with BH-MCO to develop prescriber and pharmacy interventions that reduce unsupported atypical antipsychotic prescribing and prescribing of multiple medications to the same participant.
- Submit reports to show the participants identified and shared with the BH-MCO.
